Harry Teague's Message to New Mexico: "Do as I say, not as I do"

Hobbs, NM – New Mexicans are expressing shock at a news story coming out of Washington, DC on Harry Teague's health care views. Apparently while Harry Teague was lecturing New Mexico businesses on the need to provide Health Insurance to employees he was ordering his companies to terminate the health insurance policies of his employees.

The story titled "Harry Teague's companies cut health care" ran in today's *Politico* newspaper in Washington, DC.
