## **Diane and Bill—the other one**

ALBUQUERQUE, NM – Today, Lieutenant Governor Diane Denish will cash in on her relationship with the Clinton family by hosting a fundraising reception with the former president.

“It is surprising that after announcing on television her aversion to the ‘good ‘ole boy’ club, Diane Denish is bringing Bill Clinton, poster boy for the Washingtonian elite, to campaign for her in New Mexico,” noted Nina Martinez, the Republican Party of New Mexico’s first vice chair. “Apparently, with her other ally, Bill Richardson, continuing to nosedive in approval ratings, Denish is looking for another political mentor.”
